

hirty-five years ago a little movie opened the weekend before Thanksgiving, was a moderate success, and was out of all but a handful of movie theatres by Christmas Day. Then it started showing up on television during the holiday season and people couldn't get enough of this charming,

nostalgic tale. By 1997 Turner Broadcasting was showing it every year

continuously for 24 hours beginning on Christmas Eve. Of course we're talking about the phenomenal success of *A Christmas Story*. It has become an annual tradition for millions.


