

Director's Note



et me be honest...I have never been a Neil Simon fan. No, really. I've found Mr. Simon's work to be occasionally misogynistic (much influenced by cultural norms) and often uneven in tone and structure. I took on *Barefoot in the Park* as a challenge to my own literary and theatrical sensibilities, and to appreciate an artist's work that has touched so many, but that has somehow escaped me. Am I a Neil Simon fan now that I have had the experience of directing *Barefoot*? Again, let me be honest. No.

But don't get me wrong, I do understand and appreciate Simon's appeal. He has a way of creating characters that allows an audience an easy connection, characters who say and do the things we always wanted to (and sometimes do), especially at our most ridiculous moments. And the best part of directing *Barefoot* has been our cast. Jamie Meckley has wonderfully carried the show on her shoulders as Corie. Chad Ridgway helped create fantastic chemistry as Paul. Rena Swearingen made Mrs. Banks the most loved and dreaded of mothers. Mitch Mazaher brought to life the unstoppable force that is Victor Velasco. William D. Roberts made himself at home as the telephone repairman Harry Pepper. And Bill (if-you-blink-you'll-miss-him) Knotts starts the show off just right as the delivery man.

These actors creating these characters from Mr. Simon's story of a newlywed couple make this show enjoyable from top to bottom. I do love these characters and how they push each other's buttons. Honestly, you are going to love them, too.


