Director's Note

ver thirty years ago a friend demanded that I watch the 1951 black-and-white movie, *Scrooge* starring the great Alastair Sims in the eponymous title role. I was skeptical but I agreed and I am so thankful that I did, because this movie is now a Smith household tradition every Christmas. At the moment of the famous, old miser's true salvation, I wept like a baby at the sheer beauty of Scrooge's transformation, God's forgiveness, and His redeeming love. And make no mistake, this is a



story of Divine Grace, Charles Dickens' novel makes that abundantly clear.

We honor that message tonight. The version you are about to see is closely based on the 1971 musical movie version of *Scrooge*, starring Albert Finney and to many, it is a Christmastime favorite. Finney was a young man at the time the movie was released, but his portrayal of old Scrooge was masterful. You will have a wonderful time tonight, of that you may be certain, and we all are so grateful you've come to see the production. As Tom Jenkins would say, "Thank you very much!"

"Scrooge was better than his word. He did it all, and infinitely more; and to Tiny Tim, who did NOT die, he was a second father. He became as good a friend, as good a master, and as good a man, as the good old city knew, or any other good old city, town, or borough, in the good old world... and it was always said of him, that he knew how to keep Christmas well, if any man alive possessed the knowledge. May that be truly said of all of us! And so, as Tiny Tim observed, God Bless Us, Every One!"




