





tion, we talked a lot about this, and I'm excited about what we are bringing to the stage.



It is music from start to finish filled with harmonies, key changes, intricate rhythms, etc. From auditions forward, I have been beyond impressed with their commitment to learning this music beyond their abilities.

Seussical JR. is only alive on stage because of Sherry, Helen, Drew, Barbara, Rod, Lynda, Connie, Carrie, Alice, Becky, Hannah, Emma, and so many more that have made it possible. 




