Tonight we are presenting a show that was groundbreaking on Broadway in 1970 and ground-breaking for us when we presented it here for the first time in 1980

and we still love its ground-breaking qualities now, decades later.

We're always looking for a perfectly balanced season which would contain something for musical lovers, for drama lovers, for comedy lovers, for family audiences, and for those who love new and cutting-edge shows.

So, whether you're a fan of musicals, dramas, comedies, mysteries, or cutting edge shows, we're so glad you're here and hope you enjoy our carefully crafted, balanced season and this great show!


