




Director's Note

elcome to the fun-filled yet philosophical world of Charles Schulz and the Peanuts gang!

On March 7, 1967, *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown* – a charming musical adaptation of Charles Schultz's classic Peanuts comic strip – premiered Off-Broadway featuring most of

the classic characters from the strip at the time - Charlie Brown, Schroeder, Lucy, Linus, Snoopy, and Lucy's friend Patty (a now outdated Peanuts character not to be confused with Peppermint Patty who didn't exist yet). This production lasted 1,597 performances, closing on February 14, 1971. A Broadway production opened on June 1, 1971. After nine national tours, the show quickly became a staple of community theaters and schools because of its small cast and simple staging.

In my eighth-grade year, at Jackson Junior High School, I played bass keyboard for the ninth-grade drama class' production of *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown*. I fell in love and vowed that one day I would play Charlie Brown in the show. Many years went by, many shows came and went... but, alas, no chance to play Charlie Brown.

In 1999 a big scale Broadway revival of *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown* opened on February 4. This new version featured new dialogue taken from strips published in the years since the original show premiered, the character of Sally Brown replacing the original's now obsolete character of Patty, and two new songs by Andrew Lippa, composer of *The Addams Family* and *Big Fish*.

That same summer I worked my first season of summer stock theater at the Millbrook Playhouse in Mill Hall, PA. The final show of the season was *Snoopy: The Musical!* I was cast and FINALLY got to play Charlie Brown, albeit in the OTHER, lesser known Peanuts musical. Then, a few years ago, MOVP was putting on *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown* and I knew this was the chance I'd been waiting for. But then, something happened. As I prepared for auditions the role of Snoopy started calling to me. So, I refocused my efforts and ended up getting that role instead, going on to win an MOVP Khalil for my efforts.

Now things have come (almost) full circle and here I am directing the show that started it all for me - *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown*! It's been a long journey garnering me a lifetime of memories and an entire shelf full of Peanuts memorabilia! Many thanks to the cast and crew that have worked tirelessly to help bring this whimsical world to life, thanks to the creators of the show, and mostly my undying gratitude goes to Charles Schulz for gifting us with his beautiful creations.




