





Two relative unknowns were hired to write the score: Matthew Sklar to write the music and Chad Beguelin to write the lyrics. Their only Broadway credit at that time was the musical version of "The Wedding Singer". Since "Elf", they have gone on to write the recent hit musical



"The Prom" which was turned into an even more successful Netflix film. Beguelin also wrote the book and additional lyrics for the stage version of Disney's "Aladdin".

The show first ran on Broadway during the Christmas season of 2010-2011 to soldout houses. And returned to Broadway again for the holidays in 2012-2013. It has played London's West End, toured extensively around the United States and England to delighted audiences, and made into a stop-motion animated adaptation for television. 
