

On stage she appeared as The Lady of the Lake in *Spamalot* and in *Into the Woods* as Cinderella in 1992 and as the Witch in 2011. She was awarded the Khalil Award twice for her performances as Patsy Cline in *Always, Patsy Cline* and as Donna in *Mamma Mia!* She appeared in many others since 1985. Sherry is employed as a school nurse for Wood County Schools.

SETH FEARNOW has been in a couple shows and he could waste his word count telling you which ones, but that's not really what you need to know is it? Directing credits: Fiddler on the Roof, Addams Family, Shrek, Rent, Avenue Q, Doubt, Annie, Tommy; music directing: Christmas Story, Full Monty, Spamalot. She is a member of the Guild's Board of Trustees, a retired music teacher (Neale School), active at the Smoot Theatre with Camp Vaudeville, and directs The Smoot Theatre Children's Chorus.

HEATHER HEPBURN has been with the Actors Guild of Parkersburg since 2004. You may have caught her as Deloris in *Sister Act*, or Rosie in *Mamma Mia!* Some

of her other favorites were Paulette, Motor Mouth Maybelle, Bloody Mary, Eddie/Dr. Scott and Gary Coleman. She has won several regional OCTA awards including Outstanding in Acting for Ms. Muller in *Doubt*. Heather has had the pleasure of directing both here and at MOVP where *The Odd Couple* won multiple awards including Best Show. She also won the Khalil Award there for Steele in *A Piece of My Heart*.

REINNIE LEAVITT was most recently on stage as Mother in A Christmas Story. She has been in numerous AGP productions including: Company, 9 to 5, Into the Woods, Man of La Mancha, Big The Musical, The Civil War and many more.
