Director's Note

am thrilled to be directing *Newsies* at the Guild! This story has been close to my heart since the movie came out in 1992. It is something I have not seen here before! There are so many people who have helped us Seize the Day in this production so even if you were not named, please know that your contributions have been so helpful.

I'm not going to lie - I was extremely nervous going into auditions for this show. I have been away from the Guild for a few years and I really didn't know some of the fresh talent. It didn't take long though for those nerves to disappear and I feel that we have the perfect cast. We had a great turnout for auditions and we had to cut some talented people. Yes, we have both male and female Newsies which is historically accurate. I have enjoyed working with all of them and admire their determination to "get it right". I want to extend a wholehearted thank you to them for helping me bring this dream of directing Newsies to life.

On a personal note, the last time I directed, my life was in a very different place. One of the main messages in *Newsies* is to stick to your principles and seize the day when things get tough. Sometimes you have to stand up and fight for what you believe is right without losing who you really are. This message rings very true for me on so many levels. It took me a long time to be confident in myself and believe in myself. Thank you Hannah, Lydia, Riley, Chett, and so many more who allow me to be my authentic self and give me something to believe in.


