



PARTICIPATION PERMISSION FORM

FOR:

The Actors Guild of Parkersburg (AGP) shall establish and perpetuate live community theater respected and supported by the public in any form deemed appropriate by and desired by membership. It shall further be the purpose of the AGP to provide educational programs in any aspect of community theater.

The AGP shall strive to provide a safe and welcoming environment for all participants involved in its creative and educational efforts.

In the event that a person aged 17 years or younger (henceforth referred to as a “minor”) is involved with a function at the AGP, certain guidelines must be acknowledged and agreed upon by the minor’s parent/guardian. That acknowledgment and agreement will be recognized with a signature at the end of this document.

The guidelines are as follows:

- The minor and his or her parent/guardian must adhere to and follow all matters outlined in the AGP “Respect” policy.
- The minor shall not imbibe in any substance or participate in any activity that is illegal while on the grounds of the AGP or at an event with AGP sponsorship.
- In the course of rehearsal and performance of a theatrical production, the minor and his or her parent/guardian will be advised by the director (or the director’s emissary) if adult language will be used around or by the minor and/or if adult behavior will be required of the minor. Discomfort from any parties with such requirements must be discussed with the director.
- The requirement of adult language or adult behavior within the confines of a rehearsal or performance does not insinuate such behavior would be appropriate or acceptable from the minor in other situations at the AGP.
- Depending on the production, a secondary document with specific language regarding minors may be fitting. As deemed necessary by the production’s director and/or the AGP Board of Trustees, that secondary document must be signed by the parent/guardian.
- Parents/guardians are encouraged to examine rehearsal and performance schedules and are encouraged to discuss the commitments therein with the minor in their charge. Heeding these schedules is necessary for a successful experience.
- Failure to adhere to these guidelines may result in the removal of the minor from the production or the AGP-sponsored event.

The purpose of this document is to provide expectations of behavior concerning minors involved with the AGP. Any concerns about this document should be discussed with the production’s director or event leader before this document is signed. Parents/guardians are always welcome to observe rehearsals and other events at the AGP and are encouraged to volunteer at the theater.
